- (iv) Work experience in any area of Clinical Pharmacy will be an added advantage.
- (v) Relevant supporting reference from the employer (for in-service applicants).

Duration of programme: Master of Science programme is expected to complete within **36** month AND should not take more than 48 months.

(c) Master of Science (Physiotherapy in Orthopaedics)

The applicant must possess

- (i) Bachelor's degree in Physiotherapy from the University of Zambia or an equivalent qualification from a recognized University.
- (ii) Full registration with the Health Professions Council of Zambia (HPCZ).

(iii) Two (2) years professional work experience in Physiotherapy is an added advantage.

Duration of programme: Master of Science programme is expected to complete within **18 AND** should not take more than 24 months.

(d) Masters Programmes by Research
